

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR REVIEW
FOR THE NEW COMMERCIAL SERVICE TERMINAL BUILDING AT
CONCORD REGIONAL AIRPORT
CONCORD, NC**

City of Concord intends to submit a request for state and federal financial assistance with the Federal Aviation Administration and North Carolina Department of Transportation Division of Aviation to help carry out the following development at the Concord Regional Airport, Concord, NC:

The Proposed Action is the construction of a new commercial service terminal with associated access road and automobile parking lot. The commercial service terminal building will be approximately 25,000 square feet with 15 percent of the facility being designated for private use by airlines and the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and 85 percent to be available for public space. Currently, commercial service is being operated out of an up-fitted hangar adjacent to the existing general aviation terminal. Security requirements currently allow bringing the existing ramp up to a Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) status before flights and then removing the SIDA after the flight leaves. The new commercial service terminal building is proposed in an area that can have a permanent SIDA area 24-hours a day, seven days a week. Once this Proposed Action is complete, the existing commercial service aircraft will utilize the south apron expansion that is currently under construction and new commercial service terminal building.

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS are notified of the availability of the Environmental Assessment (EA) of the effects of the proposed action. The EA is available for examination during normal business hours at the following locations:

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS are further advised of an opportunity to request a public hearing by the City of Concord. A public hearing may be requested by individuals to whom the proposed action is a significant concern. The hearing requested should indicate the concerns and reasons why a hearing is requested. A public hearing may be held if it is determined that there is substantial public interest to warrant a hearing.

Before making a request for a public hearing, persons are encouraged to contact Mr. Rick Cloutier, Aviation Director, at (704) 920-5912 to express their views and discuss those aspects of the proposed action that are of concern. If a hearing is held, it will consider the social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed action and whether the action is in the public interest and consistent with the goals and objectives of area planning.
