

How to select parcels in a Recognized Neighborhood

&


Export parcel tax data



Open up the [Concord GIS Web Viewer](#) from our web page. The [Concord GIS Web Viewer](#) requires Internet Explorer or FireFox at this time. The application will not function in Chrome at the current time.

In the “I want to...” menu, select “Special Task”.



Select “Show all property owners in a neighborhood”, and press OK.



Choose your desired neighborhood, and press “Select Parcels”

The parcels will be selected, and you will be presented with an opportunity to download the Excel file. The Excel file will contain the tax parcel data for the parcels in the selected Recognized Neighborhood.
