

NEIGHBORHOOD LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

Purpose

The purpose of the Neighborhood Leadership Council is three fold. First, the Neighborhood Leadership Council (NLC) will provide an open forum where neighborhood leaders can come together to share experiences and seek advise on how to resolve common neighborhood issues. Secondly, it will provide an open exchange of information between neighborhood association leadership and the City. When there are open lines of communication information can quickly flow in both directions. The third and final purpose is to provide neighborhood leaders with access to focused leadership training.

Membership

The meetings are open to neighborhood leaders from each of the City's officially recognized neighborhood organizations. In most cases this is the neighborhood association chair or president, although any active member is welcomed to attend meetings. Recognized neighborhood organizations are encouraged to designate a primary and an alternate representative to serve as its NLC representative. The (NLC) will meet quarterly.
