Construct extension of Johnson Street

Construct street connection between Central Drive and Epworth Street

Construct street connections along Veitor, Durham and Andrew, as practical and feasible, to complete neighborhood traffic circulation pattern and connectivity

Install sidewalks in accordance with Multi-Modal Connections Map

Coordinate with First Assembly to enhance traffic circulation

Construct cul de sacs: Lee Court, Swink Street, Bost Avenue & Eden Street

Explore options to construct park along Irish Buffalo Creek

Reinforce Cabarrus Avenue as a gateway to Center City

Identify opportunities for adaptive reuse and restoration and utilization of historic preservation tax credits for existing mills

Promote benefits of state development zone & New Markets Tax Credits
