

These strategies should be implemented jointly by public, private, non-profit and other neighborhood organizations

Facilitate development of options for residents to relocate into new homes within the community

Develop multiple options for housing within the community for seniors

Ensure the provision of affordable housing opportunities within the community

Promote and enhance the existing home buying training program through the Cabarrus Community Development Corporation

Build new housing on sites of existing public housing (Chapman Homes & Logan Homes) and privately owned homes between Caldwell Park and Lincoln Street to create a variety of owner occupied and mixed income housing

Create a Main Street in the neighborhood by: Connecting Lincoln Street through to Corban Avenue, constructing sidewalks along the Lincoln Street bridge, and where feasible, installing sidewalks, street trees, street lights and other traffic calming measures along Lincoln Street

Enhance connections of existing public facilities at Caldwell Park and Logan School Site to Lincoln Street

Implement a marketing program to promote neighborhood identity

Create a community focal point at Five Points (intersection of Lincoln, High & Tournament)

Explore opportunities to relocate the recreational functions of the Logan Multi-Purpose Center to Caldwell Park

Develop a cultural center with the community

Install sidewalks in accordance with Multi-Modal Connections Map

Construct cul de sacs: Harold Place, Dresden Place, Woody Court, Cypress Street, Klutz Court & Cline Court

Promote benefits of state development zone, federal historically underutilized business zone and New Markets Tax Credits
