

## National Night Out 2016

What is National Night Out? National Night Out, sponsored by the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF TOWN WATCH, is a national neighborhood crime and drug prevention event that occurs annually on the first Tuesday in August. It is celebrated in numerous cities, towns and villages in the United States. Over the past 33 years, National Night Out has grown to over 37 million people in over 15,000 communities from all 50 states, US territories, Canadian cities, and military bases worldwide.



**This year marks the 15th year of National Night out Celebration for the City of Concord.**



In addition to increasing awareness of crime, NNO strengthens neighborhood bonds and community-police partnerships, while sending a message to criminals that neighborhoods are taking a stand against crime! Bonded neighborhoods deter crime by sending the message that you are close to your neighbors and everyone is aware of what is happening in your neighborhood, and is watching out for each other.

In observance of **National Night Out on Tuesday, August 2, 2016**, the Concord Police Department asks that at minimum you leave your porch light on from 7:00 p.m – 10:00 p.m. The porch light is a symbol of alertness and awareness; it also makes your neighbors and friends feel welcome. Participation is not limited to leaving your porch light on August 4. We would like you to get to know your neighbors better. You can do this by going door to door and introducing yourself if you have not done so in the past. Feel free to organize neighborhood activities such as block parties, cookouts, porch sittings, and other events to show your “**no-tolerance**” for crime.
