# 1. WSACC sewer allocation update

The Water Resources Director, Jeff Corley, stated the WSACC Board approved an interlocal agreement for sewer allocation. Each municipality will have to also approve the agreement.

The Water Resources Director provided allocation ideas for Council's consideration and discussion was held. It was the consensus of the Council to include Midland in the allocation plans. The City Attorney suggested the Council enter into an agreement with Midland for their allocation.
