CONCORD, NORTH CAROLINA
SCHEDULE 11-TS
TRAFFIC SIGNAL SERVICE**

AVAILABILITY

Available to municipalities in which the City owns and operates the electric distribution system, and to County, State and Federal Authorities in areas served by the City, for the energy requirements of traffic and safety signal systems.

Power delivered under this schedule shall not be used for resale or exchange or in parallel with other electric power, or as a substitute for power contracted for or which may be contracted for, under any other schedule of the City.

TYPE OF SERVICE

The City will furnish 60 Hertz service through one meter, at one delivery point, at 120/240 volts, single-phase.

RATE

\$6.50	Basic Facilities Charge
18.8151 cents per KWh for the first	50 KWh used per month
8.6328 cents per KWh for all over	50 KWh used per month

DEFINITION OF "MONTH"

The term "month" as used in this Schedule means the period intervening between meter readings for the purposes of monthly billing. Readings are taken once a month at intervals of approximately thirty (30) days.

MINIMUM BILL

The monthly minimum charge shall be \$3.62.

PURCHASE POWER ADJUSTMENT RIDER

The City's Purchase Power Adjustment Rider is applicable to all service supplied under this schedule.

RENEWABLE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARD (REPS) RIDER

The City's Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard (REPS) Rider is applicable to all service supplied under this schedule.

PAYMENT

Bills are due and payable upon receipt. Bills become delinquent in 25 days from the date of the bill. Final notices will be sent on the 30th day from the date of the bill. Cut-off of service for non-payment of the bill will occur on the 45th day from the date of the bill. Billing will be done in three cycles. The bills for each cycle are mailed on the following dates:

- CYCLE I - Mailed on the 10th of the month
- CYCLE II - Mailed on the 20th of the month
- CYCLE III - Mailed on the 30th of the month

Customer Service Representatives are available Monday - Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 to hear any grievance a customer may have regarding a possible billing error and to work with financially distressed customers to make payment arrangement.

A reconnection fee will be charged to have services reconnected and will be as follows:

- \$50.00 - During regular working hours -
Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- \$100.00 - After regular working hours and weekends

EXTRA FACILITIES CHARGE

A monthly "Extra Facilities Charge" equal to 1.7% of the installed cost of extra facilities necessary for service required under this schedule, but not less than \$25, shall be billed to the Customer in addition to the bill under the appropriate rate schedule when applicable.

A utility late fee of 1 ½ percent will be charged on all unpaid balances, with a maximum fee of \$10 per month. A late fee will apply if payment is not paid by the 26th day. Effective 7/7/00, new payment arrangements are subject to late fee. Prior payment arrangements are not subject to late fee unless not current.
