

All parades, assemblies or events will start and end promptly at the times indicated on the permit.

All parades or events will be conducted in accordance with the laws of North Carolina and City Ordinances of Concord, to-wit sections 50-250 through 50-263.

Variation from the specified area may be grounds for the Chief of Police to cancel the permit.

The following acts or activities, when performed or undertaken in conjunction with or as part of a parade or public assembly, are hereby prohibited and declared unlawful:

1. The carrying on or about the person any firearms, or any weapon or article, including, but not limited to blackjacks or flashlights, which by their use might constitute a deadly weapon.
2. The taking or keeping of any dog or vicious animal, whether leashed or unleashed.
3. Entry onto private property without owner's permission.
4. Failure to comply with any conditions of this parade/assembly permit.
5. Unreasonable or unnecessary interference with the safe and orderly movement of other pedestrian or vehicular traffic contiguous to parade or assembly route.

Parades and public assemblies shall also be subject to the following additional regulations:

6. It shall be unlawful for any person participating in any picket to carry or possess any staff or pole for purposes of displaying any sign, poster, flag, banner, plaque or notice unless the staff or pole is:
 - a. made of corrugated material (plastic or wood),
 - b. less than 41 inches in length,
 - c. $\frac{1}{4}$ " or less in thickness and 2" in width,
 - d. blunt at both ends.
7. It shall be unlawful for any person participating in any picket to carry or possess any sign, poster, flag, banner, plaque or notice, whether or not mounted on a length of material as specified above, unless such sign, poster, flag, banner, plaque or notice is constructed or made of a cloth, paper, cardboard, rubber or plastic material.
8. It shall be unlawful to interfere with the use of a sidewalk or street requested by another applicant to whom a valid parade/assembly permit application has already been granted or has been received and will be granted.
