

## FAQ for Summer Playground

- 1) What is the fee for Summer Playground?  
The fee for City of Concord residents is \$300/child. For non-city residents the fee is \$400/child. There is a \$100 deposit due at registration. Balance is due by Friday, June 13.
- 2) Do I get a discount if I have more than one child registering?  
At this time we do not offer a discount.
- 3) How do I register for Summer Playground?  
You can register online at [www.concordparksandrec.org](http://www.concordparksandrec.org) beginning Thursday, 3/6 at 8:00 am and Friday, 3/7 until 5:00 pm. It will resume on Wednesday, 3/12 at 8:00 am. You can also walk-in and register beginning Tuesday, 3/11 at 8:00 am – 5:00 pm.
- 4) How do I know if I live within the Concord city limits?  
You are a resident if you reside within the City Limits of Concord. If you are still not sure please call 704-920-5600.
- 5) Where are the playgrounds located?  
Hartsell Park- 60 Hartsell School Rd. NW  
Les Myers Park- 338 Lawndale Ave. SE  
Caldwell Park- 362 Georgia Ave. SW
- 6) What time do the playgrounds open and close?  
Program hours are 7:30 am – 6:00 pm
- 7) Who are the Summer Playground leaders?  
Many of our staff works in the Cabarrus County Schools.
- 8) What is the ratio of leaders to children?  
1:15 (One leader for every 15 children)
- 9) Do I need to pack my child a lunch?  
Bring snacks, water bottles and lunch. Lunches will be provided at Hartsell Park, Caldwell Park, and Myers Park through the Cabarrus County Schools' Summer Nutrition Program.
- 10) Are there any extra costs?  
The fee includes trips and program offerings.
